COLLEGE OPTION FORM for selecting ELECTIVES

(For I, III, and V Semester Students – Academic Session 2026-27)

Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences welcomes all students to the Academic Session 2026–27. The College follows the **Four-Year Undergraduate Curriculum Framework (UGCF–2022)** of the University of Delhi, implemented in accordance with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. All undergraduate students are required to pursue their studies as per the provisions of this curriculum framework. Students are advised to familiarize themselves with the curriculum, programme structure, and course details through the following resources: [Undergraduate Curriculum Framework \(UGCF–2022\)](#) and [College Prospectus 2026–27](#).

Under UGCF–2022, each programme comprises different categories of courses. While Core Courses are compulsory for students of a particular programme, several categories of Elective Courses provide students with the opportunity to choose courses based on their academic interests and career aspirations.

This **Course Option Form** is being circulated to collect students' preferences for the elective and other choice-based courses to be offered during the Academic Session **2026–27**. The information provided will be used for course allocation and preparation of the academic timetable, subject to University regulations and availability of seats.

Please exercise due care while selecting your course preferences, as changes may not be permitted after the stipulated deadline except as per University guidelines. Some of the salient features of UGCF 2022 are provided below:

1. All B.Sc. (Hons) degrees in different disciplines or major streams are now referred to as 'Programmes,' and students are considered to be enrolled in that specific discipline for eg. B.Sc.(H) Botany etc. The individual subjects/papers taught within these Programmes/Disciplines are referred to as 'Courses'.
2. Each Programme/Discipline offers three categories of courses: Discipline Specific Core courses (DSCs), Discipline Specific Electives (DSEs), and Generic Electives (GEs). Discipline Specific Core courses (DSCs) are mandatory courses that a student must study within their chosen Programme/Discipline. Discipline Specific Electives (DSEs) comprise a pool of credit-based courses within the student's own discipline.
3. Students may select these courses based on their academic interests. Generic Electives (GEs) are designed to provide a multidisciplinary or interdisciplinary learning experience. Students are NOT permitted to select GE courses offered by their own department.
If a student chooses a DSE from another discipline, it will be considered as a Generic Elective (GE) for that student.
4. In addition to the core and elective courses, students are also required to study the following courses:
 - Ability Enhancement Course (AEC)
 - Skill Enhancement Course (SEC)
 - Value Addition Course (VAC)

These courses are offered as a common pool across all departments, allowing students to choose based on their interests. Students are permitted to select SEC and VAC courses offered by their own department.



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Criteria for Major and Minor Disciplines – UGCF (University of Delhi)

Major Discipline:

1. A student enrolled in a four-year undergraduate programme in a specific discipline (Core Programme) shall be awarded an Honours degree with a Major in that discipline upon successful completion of the VIII Semester, provided that the student secures at least 50% of the total credits, i.e., a minimum of 88 credits out of 176 in that discipline.
2. The student must complete 20 Discipline Specific Core (DSC) courses and at least 2 Discipline Specific Electives (DSEs) over eight semesters. *For example*, a student pursuing B.Sc. (Honours) in Botany must earn a minimum of 88 credits through 20 DSCs and at least 2 DSEs to be awarded a Major in Botany.

Minor Discipline:

1. A student may be eligible to earn a Minor in a discipline other than their core discipline only after completion of the VIII Semester. The specific modalities and implementation guidelines are being finalized by the University of Delhi and will be adopted by the college accordingly. These will be officially notified to all students.
2. As per the UGCF guidelines, to earn a Minor in a particular discipline, a student must secure a minimum of 28 credits by completing seven Generic Elective (GE) courses in that discipline. *For instance*, if a student pursuing B.Sc. (Honours) in Botany chooses seven GE courses from Biomedical Science (out of the ten total GE courses) and completes the required dissertation in their main discipline, they will be awarded, upon successful completion of the VIII Semester, a Major in Botany and a Minor in Biomedical Science.



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Course Selection Guidelines under UGCF – 2022

As mentioned above, and in accordance with the Undergraduate Curriculum Framework – 2022 (UGCF–2022), students have the flexibility to choose from a pool of multidisciplinary electives and skill-based courses to enrich their academic experience. Below is a semester-wise summary of the courses that students are required to select based on their year of enrolment:

First Year Students (Enrolled in the year 2026): Students are required to choose the following three courses to be studied during each of the I and II Semesters: One Generic Elective (GE) course; One Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) and One Value Addition Course (VAC)

Second Year Students (Enrolled in the year 2025): Students are required to choose the following three courses to be studied during each of the III and IV Semesters: One Generic Elective (GE) course *OR* One Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) course (from their own discipline); One Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) and One Value Addition Course (VAC)

Note: If a student opts for a DSE course of other department, it will be treated as a GE for credit and degree purposes.

Third Year Students (Enrolled in the year 2024): Students must select the following four courses to be studied during each of the V and VI Semesters: One Generic Elective (GE) course; One Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) course (from their own discipline); One Skill Enhancement Course (SEC); One Value Addition Course (VAC)

Fourth Year (FYUP) Students (Enrolled in the year 2023): Students entering the seventh and eighth semesters of the four-year undergraduate programme will be required to pursue advanced learning and research-focused components. A separate course selection form will be shared with these students for:

1. Discipline Specific Electives (DSEs)
2. Generic Electives (GEs)
3. Academic Project / Dissertation / Entrepreneurship options

The detailed structure and guidelines for the FYUP Honours with Research / Honours with Entrepreneurship will be shared by the college in due course. **A separate form for all fourth-year students will be circulated through the respective Departments.**

Important Advisory for Students Regarding Elective Course Selection

As per directions from the University of Delhi, students will not receive any credits for studying two different courses with overlapping or similar content, regardless of whether they are Core (DSC), Generic Elective (GE), or any other Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) course type.



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Please carefully read **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS, DON'Ts and NOTES:**

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- Login to your Gmail Account to fill the form.
- Select your GE, SEC, VAC COURSES carefully in your order of preference.
- III Semester students can choose DSE course instead of a GE course offered by a discipline in which they wish to do their Minor, in case he/she is not interested in studying the GE course offered by that department. *Such DSE courses will be considered as GE for that student.*
- A confirmation with "Edit Response" will be sent to your email (May go to SPAM).
- Generate the confirmation number as per the instruction for future reference.
- Get your confirmation number (after submission) on this link.
- Use "Edit Response" link received in your mail to change after submission. Confirmation number won't change and remain the same. Only the latest response will be considered in case of multiple responses.

DONT's

- Don't choose GE papers offered by your **own** department.
- Don't fill same course in two or more preferences.
- Don't share the confirmation mail with anyone, she may overwrite your response with new records which will leave your response blank. The college will not be responsible for this.

NOTES

- Allotment of GE, SEC, VAC options will be based purely on **Merit cum Preference** basis as per the number of seats offered by a department concerned.
- Class XII result will be considered for GE-I, SEC-I and VAC-I (students enrolled in I year) for deciding the merit of the student.
- I and II Semester result will be considered for SEC-III, VAC-III, GE-III/DSE-III (students of II year) for deciding the merit of the student.
- III and IV Semester result will be considered for SEC-V, VAC-V, GE-V/DSE-V (students of III year) for deciding the merit of the student.
- In case of false information or/and duplicate entry of the subject, the form is likely to be rejected. You may not get your preferred GE/SEC/VAC option.
- The college reserves the right to allot the required GE/SEC/VAC/DSE option on its own.
- No change will be allowed after the due date and time notified on the form.

Third-year students are required to complete two Discipline Specific Electives (DSEs) in their core discipline in the academic year 2026-27 to be eligible for the Honours degree in their admitted discipline.

P. S. : A separate form for all fourth-year students will be circulated through the respective Departments.

Submission Deadline and Late Penalty:

- The course selection portal will remain active until **July 25, 2026, 8:00 pm for 2 and 3 year students.**
- A penalty of 5–10% marks may be imposed for late submission.
- These are compulsory courses, and if a student fails to submit preferences within the stipulated time, the college reserves the right to allocate courses at its discretion.

Students are Advised To:

- Carefully review the syllabus and subject scope/career opportunities of various courses.
- Prepare a priority list before accessing the online form to ensure thoughtful and timely submission.
