Manner of Execution of Fee Concession and Financial Assistance Scheme

[Section 4(1)(b)(xii)]

Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences (BCAS), a constituent college of the University of Delhi, provides fee concession and financial assistance to eligible students belonging to economically weaker sections. The assistance is granted subject to the prescribed criteria, recommendations of the competent committee, and availability of funds.

Particulars	Information
Name of the Programme/Activity	Fee Concession and Financial Assistance Scheme
Objective of the Programme	To provide financial support to meritorious and economically weaker students.
Procedure to Avail Benefits	Eligible students submit the prescribed application with supporting documents. Applications are scrutinized by the designated committee before approval.
Duration of the Programme/Scheme	Implemented annually during each academic session.
Physical and Financial Targets	Subject to the number of eligible applicants and availability of funds.
Nature/Scale of Assistance	Partial or full fee concession as approved by the competent authority.
Eligibility Criteria	Economically weaker students fulfilling the criteria prescribed by the College.
Details of Beneficiaries	Maintained by the College and updated annually.

Competent Authority

Applications are examined by the Fee Concession/Student Advisory Committee and approved by the Principal.
