Particulars of Recipients of Concessions, Permits or Authorizations Granted by the Public Authority

[Section 4(1)(b)(xiii)]

Bhaskaracharya College of Applied Sciences (BCAS), a constituent college of the University of Delhi, does not grant permits, licences or statutory authorizations to individuals or organizations. However, the College provides fee concession/financial assistance to eligible students belonging to economically weaker sections in accordance with the approved rules and recommendations of the competent committee. The College may also issue administrative permissions and No Objection Certificates (NOCs) to students and employees as per the applicable University and College rules.

A. Fee Concession / Financial Assistance

Particulars	Details
Nature of Concession	Fee Concession / Financial Assistance to eligible students.
Eligibility Criteria	Students belonging to economically weaker sections fulfilling the criteria prescribed by the College from time to time.
Procedure	Application in the prescribed format with supporting documents. Applications are scrutinized by the Fee Concession/Student Aid Committee and approved by the Principal.
Recipients	The list of beneficiaries is maintained by the College. Personal information of students is protected in accordance with the Right to Information Act, 2005 and applicable privacy provisions. Aggregate year-wise data may be disclosed.
Date of Award	Fee concessions are awarded during each academic session after completion of the scrutiny and approval process.

B. Administrative Permissions / Authorizations

The College issues administrative permissions and No Objection Certificates (NOCs), wherever applicable, to students and employees in accordance with the University of Delhi Ordinances, Rules and College regulations. These are granted on a case-to-case basis by the competent authority.
